

General Terms and Conditions for Group Registrations

1 Application of these General Terms and Conditions

These General Terms and Conditions apply when the Client buys a certain number of rights to register participants for the European Annual Congress of Rheumatology 2021 to be held virtually and/or face-to-face and to take place until 5 July 2021, 23.59 CEST (hereinafter "**Congress**"). The Congress is organised by European League Against Rheumatism EULAR, Seestrasse 240, 8802 Kilchberg, Switzerland, Telephone: +41 44 716 30 30, email: congress@eular.org (hereinafter "**EULAR**"). Group registrations are possible until 24hrs before the end of the Congress.

2 Congress

2.1 The Congress

EULAR will organize a virtual annual European Congress of Rheumatology and intends to organise a face-to-face annual European Congress of Rheumatology to be held in Paris from 2 to 5 June 2021 with a reduced number of participants, whereby EULAR still is uncertain whether such EULAR Congress will take place due to the uncertainties linked to the COVID-19 diseases.

The aim of the Congress is to provide a forum of the highest standard for scientific (both clinical and basic), educational and social exchange between professionals involved in rheumatology, liaising with patient organisations, in order to achieve progress in the clinical care of people with rheumatic diseases.

2.2 Programme of the Congress and Modification

The programme of the Congress will be published on the Congress Website.

EULAR reserves the right to modify the programme. No refunds will be granted in case of modification, cancellation of speakers or any other incident during the Congress.

2.3 Language

Unless otherwise specified, all lectures, basic science and clinical symposia, abstract sessions, presentations and discussions, workshops and special interest group sessions are in English.

2.4 CME credits

EULAR intends to apply for EACCME®/CME accreditation for the Congress.

Following accreditation, registered participants to the Congress can claim their CME credits and certificate of attendance by completion of an online survey. An email will be sent directly to the registered email address. After submitting the survey, the participant will receive a certificate to the indicated email address. EACCME® credits are recognised throughout Europe and in North America. EACCME®/CME credits can be exchanged for their national equivalent by contacting the national CME Authority.

Physicians may convert EACCME® credits to an equivalent number of AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™.

3 Group Registration and Participants

3.1 In General

Group registration is possible until 4 July 2021, 23.59 CEST.

Group registration is open for the registration of two or more participants. The Client can process the group registration directly through the EULAR Website by using the company access (group) portal.

3.2 Participants

The Client can register participants to the Congress if they are at least 18 years old when attending the Congress.

The Client has to ensure that the registered participants are informed of their registration and that they agree to the General Terms and Conditions for Individuals, which can be found on the EULAR Website.

The Client has to ensure that the registered participants are informed of the data processing as set out in these General Terms and Conditions and that they have consented thereto.

3.3 Full Delegates

3.3.1 Full Delegates 1

Full Delegates 1 are members of the medical, dental or pharmacy professions who, in the course of his or her professional activities may prescribe, recommend, purchase, supply, sell or administer a pharmaceutical product.

EULAR will request a confirmation on the right to prescribe pharmaceutical products during the registration process.

3.3.2 Full Delegates 2

Full Delegates 2 are medical or scientific professionals, M.D's, PhD's, who are not allowed to prescribe, recommend, purchase, supply, sell or administer a pharmaceutical product.

3.4 HPR Delegates

3.4.1 HPR Delegates 1

HPR Delegates 1 are members of the HPR Delegates, e.g. nursing professions, who, in the course of his or her professional activities may prescribe, recommend, purchase, supply, sell or administer a pharmaceutical product.

A letter of confirmation by the Head of Unit or Institute, showing the status, must be provided when registering as HPR-Delegate. EULAR will also request a confirmation on the right to prescribe pharmaceutical products during the registration process.

3.4.2 HPR Delegates 2

HPR Delegates 2 are health professional who are not allowed to prescribe, recommend, purchase, supply, sell or administer a pharmaceutical product, such as nurses, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, etc.

A letter of confirmation by the Head of Unit or Institute, showing the status, must be provided when registering as HPR-Delegate.

3.5 Trainees

3.5.1 Trainees 1

Trainees 1 are persons under 40 years of age that are Clinicians in training who, in the course of his or her professional activities may prescribe, recommend, purchase, supply, sell or administer a pharmaceutical product.

A letter of confirmation by the the Head of Unit or Institute, showing the status, must be provided when registering as Trainee. EULAR will also request a confirmation on the right to prescribe pharmaceutical products during the registration process.

3.5.2 Trainees 2

Trainees 2 are persons under 40 years of age that are Non-Tenured Scientists, i.e. scientists not being professor or associate professor, who are not allowed to prescribe, recommend, purchase, supply, sell or administer a pharmaceutical product.

A letter of confirmation by the Head of Unit or Institute, showing the status, must be provided when registering as Trainee.

3.6 Students (under 25)

Students are medical students, nurse students or in training, HPR students or in training under 25 years of age. A letter of confirmation, showing the status, must be provided when registering as Student. Proof of Age must be submitted with the registration form.

3.7 PARE Delegates

PARE Delegates are representative and / or staff members of patient organisations. A confirmation of a PARE organisation must be submitted with the registration.

3.8 Patients

Patients are persons suffering from rheumatic or musculoskeletal diseases (RMD) or their family members. A doctor's certificate must be submitted with the registration form.

3.9 Company representatives

3.9.1 Company representatives 1

Company representatives 1 are staff and representative of pharma-, medtech- and software companies or other companies which are also members of the medical, dental, pharmacy or nursing professions who, in the course of his or her professional activities may prescribe, recommend, purchase, supply, sell or administer pharmaceutical products. EULAR will request a confirmation on the right to prescribe pharmaceutical products during the registration process.

3.9.2 Company representatives 2

Company representatives 2 are staff and representatives of pharma-, medtech- and software companies or other companies, who are not allowed to prescribe, recommend, purchase, supply, sell or administer a pharmaceutical products.

4 Registration Fees

4.1 In General

The registration fees are published on the Congress Website.

4.2 Handling Fee by Credit Card Payments

Payments by credit card are subject to a handling fee of EUR 300.

4.3 Costs by Bank Transfer

All costs incurred by the Client or EULAR linked to the bank transfer, including banking fees, must be paid by the Client.

5 Invoice, Payment and Taxes

5.1 Invoicing

EULAR will invoice the registration fees by sending an invoice to the Client.

5.2 Payment Due Date and Interest

Invoices are due by the Client within 10 days of the date of issuance.

In case of default, an interest of 5% p.a. will be due. The Client is immediately in default, without the need of sending a reminder ("Fixgeschäft").

5.3 Payment by Credit Card

As long as the participants can register, the Client can pay the invoices by credit card. The following credit cards are accepted: Eurocard/Mastercard, Visa, Alipay, Amex, JCB.

The merchant name that appears on your credit card statement is EULAR.

The credit card payment will be processed through the secured gateway Saferpay to which EULAR has no access. When paying via Saferpay, the Client's data will be processed by SIX Payment Services AG, Hardturmstrasse 201, 8005 Zurich, Switzerland (hereinafter referred to as "SIX") as part of the payment process. 5.4 Payment by Bank Transfer

Until 5 May 2021, 23:59 CET at the latest, the Client can request to pay the invoices by bank transfer. All costs are to be borne by the Client, in particular all fees payable by the Client's local

The Client has to indicate the participant's or the group's name, identifier and "EULAR2021" on all payment (for example EULAR2021-I/XX or G/XX)

6 Online Registration and Admission Confirmation

The participants have to be registered online via the group portal. All fields marked as compulsory must be filled in; or else the registration is not completed. The Client can upload the registration data previously inserted in the excel template that can be found in the registration portal.

Group registrations are only possible if the Client registers all participants immediately.

The Client warrants that it will fill in the fields with true and correct data of existing natural persons. EULAR will inform the Client and the participant of the admission by sending a confirmation email. The registration portal allows the Client to download the confirmation.

7 Disclaimer of Warranty and Liability

7.1 No Warranty for Information and availability

EULAR does not warrant the completeness, accuracy and actuality of the information conveyed during the Congress, in particular the medical information.

EULAR does not warrant that the electronic platform of the Congress and the information thereon will at all times be available and error free.

The Congress does not contain any therapeutic recommendations and cannot replace the independent and complete analysis, evaluation, diagnosis, risk assessment, treatment or other medical activities by a medical specialist.

7.2 Exclusion of Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by applicable law, EULAR excludes any liability for any damages, loss, injury or liability whatsoever suffered out of or in connection with the Congress and the agreement the Client and/or the participant enters into with EULAR.

8 Cancellation of the Congress

In the event of total or partial cancellation of the virtual and/or face-to-face Congress due to fire, strike, natural disaster (either threatened or actual), communicable disease, government regulations or causes, which would prevent its scheduled opening or continuance, the contractual relationship between EULAR and the Client will be terminated immediately. EULAR shall not have to refund any registration fee already paid.

9 Feedback and Complaints

EULAR aims to provide the highest quality of services to the participants and values feedback (positive and negative) and comments. Feedback and comments can be addressed to congress@eular.org.

EULAR usually addresses complaints within one working week after receipt. If EULAR needs more time to evaluate the complaint, it will inform the person complaining of the reasons for the delay within one week.

10 Copyrights

EULAR and/or the speakers do not assign, transfer or license to the Client and/or the participant any copyright in connection with the Congress.

11 Data privacy

The Client represents and warrants that prior to providing any personal data to EULAR, in particular when filling in the registration fields, it has received the informed consent of the data subject.

In particular, the data subject has to be consented that his/her data will be processed by EULAR and its subcontractors for the purpose of organising, advertising and performing the Congress. EULAR will, for example, create participant lists and email distribution lists,

which are available to EULAR and its subcontractors. The participant will also receive information about EULAR congresses, courses, symposia and newsletters.

EULAR will also process personal data of the Client and the contact persons in charge for the purpose of fulfilling the agreement and for advertising purposes.

EULAR shall promptly notify the Client of any asserted claim. The Client, at its sole expense, shall diligently conduct the defense of such claim and all negotiations for its settlement, using competent legal advisors. EULAR shall give the Client reasonable assistance, at the Client's request and expenses.

14 Applicable law and place of jurisdiction

The substantive laws of Switzerland are applicable, with the exclusion of the conflict of law rules. The exclusive place of jurisdiction is at the seat of EULAR, currently Kilchberg, Switzerland.

15 Entry into force

These General Terms and Conditions for Group Registrations enter into force for registrations relating to the Congress 2021.
