In the permanent ambition to support the rheumatology community with the best available information and education, EULAR is collecting the contributions from all presenters in the EULAR Physical Congress in digitally recorded format. EULAR will also be broadcasting live a selection of oral presentations.

The purpose of the recording and of the live broadcasting is to make these State-of-the-Art presentations available to a wider audience. With this, the latest progress in clinical, research and patient oriented rheumatology will also be available to those not able to follow the proceedings during the conference.

Your abstract has already been made available in the ARD publication, for which you have entered into a license agreement with BMJ and EULAR. Such license agreement remains unaffected by this Agreement.

To be able to do this, EULAR is asking you to grant EULAR a licence to your poster and/or presentation, including, slides, images, voice etc. (hereinafter the "**Content**").

We consider it particularly important to clarify the following points:

- The presentation will be broadcasted live and/or will also be recorded as a video featuring the slides used during the presentation and accompanied by synchronized spoken comments and explanations
- To ensure that the live and the recorded version of the presentation are identical, the presenter will not have the option to indicate slides not to be included as part of the recording (this option is available only for presentations that are not broadcasted live)
- The recorded presentations should be accessible through the EULAR website, probably starting with the date, where you talk originally had been scheduled, and thereafter on demand.

1 License to EULAR

You herewith grant to EULAR the worldwide, perpetual right to use, broadcast (live or delayed), share, copy, store, archive and redistribute the Content in any medium or format. Except if otherwise agreed by EULAR on a case by case basis, the license is exclusive during the whole duration of the EULAR Congress.

EULAR may use, broadcast, share, copy, store and redistribute the Content free of charge or at a fee for any target audience.

EULAR may mandate any third party of its choice to execute the acquired rights.

EULAR will always indicate your name, the title of the Content and the date and event at which you have presented the Content.

2 Remuneration

Considering the projects, aims and objectives of EULAR, you provide the license stated above on a complimentary basis.

3 Confirmation and Warranty

You confirm and warrant that the Content does not infringe third party rights. In particular, you confirm that:

- You do not infringe copyrights of third parties when you introduce text, images, videos or other material, nor do you infringe personality rights, nor do you violate professional or medical secrecy obligations. Specifically, you will not introduce images of identifiable patients unless the patient has explicitly consented in writing or in another text form.
- You are not subject to any law or bound to any agreement, including but not limited to an agreement with an employer, research institution or provider of a grant or bursary that would prevent you of granting the rights as considered in this Agreement.

4 Applicable Law and Place of Jurisdiction

This Agreement is subject to material Swiss law, to the exclusion of conflict of law rules. The exclusive place of jurisdiction is at the seat of EULAR.
